SHIRTS

- Polo style
- Oxford shirts
- Solid color T-shirts (no writing), in any color
- PBGCHS Club or Athletic shirts
- College or University shirts
- Girl's Polo shirts should show modesty at all times
- All shirts must have sleeves
- Must cover mid drift area
- Dress code shirts must be worn under all jackets

PANTS, SHORTS, AND SKIRTS

Pants must be worn at the natural waistline.

- Docker style and Cargo
- Jeans are permitted with **NO** holes, **NO** rips above the knee
- Knee length skirts/skorts (with **NO** slits) and shorts
- Only gym shorts with College/University or Gator logo are permitted

SHOES

- PBGHS strongly recommend closed-toed shoes with moderate heels for your safety

UNACCEPTABLE CLOTHING:

- **NO** R.I.P. or T-shirts with graphics
- **NO** Sweatpants, Leggings, Yoga Pants, or Tights
- **NO** off the shoulder tops
- **NO** hats unless approved by administration
- **NO** Crop tops
- Any clothing that is **NOT** included in the approved Palm Beach Gardens Community High School list of clothing
